RE: Range Provides Update on Houston Outage

Yesterday at approximately 6:00 pm ET, MarkWest, the operator of the processing plant near Houston, Pennsylvania, experienced an incident which we understand involved two temporary tanks that were on-site for maintenance, resulting in a fire. The fire was extinguished by local first responders and, although the processing plant complex was not affected by the incident, it was shut down at the time of the fire as a precaution. Due to the interruption of fractionation at the Houston plant complex, Range has temporarily lost access to processing capacity at both the MarkWest Houston and Harmon Creek plants

We will provide further updates as operations at the two facilities are restored by MarkWest.

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
